In May 2006, after a nation-wide fund raising campaign to save the childhood home of author Joy Kogawa (born 1935), the tiny bungalow at 1450 West 64th Avenue in Vancouver was purchased by The Land Conservancy of British Columbia. Beginning in March 2009, as a partner with TLC, the Historic Joy Kogawa Society began hosting writers to live and work in the house on a paid basis.
